- Focus on the development, integration, and application of knowledge about medication use in older adults


WHY?

Fidget Blankets

- Started at Ohio Northern University
- Idea to address the behavioral and psychological symptoms of dementia without administering antipsychotics
 - Sensory stimulating interventions seem to help patients with these symptoms
- Students hold a drive to collect blankets, belts, beads, zippers, pockets, buttons, bells, gloves, shoelaces, small stuffed animals etc.
 - Lap sized blanket that allows for tactile, olfactory, visual, auditory stimulation
- Make blankets and deliver to local dementia units
- Offered to give us 4 blankets to get started
