Interns will also engage in ambulatory care pharmacy practice focusing on anticoagulation and chronic disease state management. As a valued member of the pharmacy team, Interns will gain exposure to both the principal distributive and advancing clinical functions of the pharmacist. Additional educational opportunities include patient counseling, medication reconciliation, drug utilization evaluation projects, as well as participation in committee meetings and pharmacist staff development activities. Interns also gain valuable presentation skills through participation in teaching Orthopedic Joint Class and a final patient case presentation to pharmacy staff.
