

- State PSHP student membership: \$28
  - Does not make you a Pitt SSHP member

## **Membership Points System**

#### Attendance

- Must pay dues to be an active member
- Must attend <u>2 out of 3</u> events per semester to be an active member

#### Points

- Must reach 15 points per semester
- Not reaching 15 points = probation for following semester
- Not reaching 15 points for 2 consecutive semesters = not permitted to join SSHP
