Cleveland Clinic Health System

Students have the opportunity to complete rotations at any of the hospitals in the health system, ambulatory pharmacies, and patient care clinics. Our Ambulatory Pharmacies are owned by Cleveland Clinic, and provide dispensing services as well as medication therapy management (MTM) and bedside delivery. Patients are seen daily in Patient Care Clinics for multiple services, including anticoagulation and diabetes management. Our Patient Care Clinics are located on hospital sites and in Family Health Centers throughout the community.

Akron General

- > 532-bed academic medical center
- > Has more than 1,000 physicians, and serves as a tertiary care, teaching hospital in the Akron region with services in high ranked specializations: cancer, cardiology, endocrinology, gastroenterology, geriatrics, level I trauma center, maternity, nephrology, orthopedics, pain management, pulmonology

Avon Hospital

- > 126-private bed hospital
- Services offered: cardiology, endocrinology, gastroenterology, general medicine, general surgery, gynecology, infectious disease, nephrology, orthopedics, ophthalmology, pulmonology, urology

Euclid Hospital

- > 167-bed acute-care facility with a 40-bed acute rehab unit
- Services offered: primary care, orthopedics, behavioral health, emergency medicine, pain management, physical, occupational and speech therapy, rehabilitation, congestive heart failure

Fairview Hospital

- > Faith based community hospital with 517 licensed beds
- Services offered: level II trauma center and cancer center; birthing center, heart center, emergency trauma and surgery, pediatric E.R, and women's preventive heart clinic

Hillcrest Hospital

- > Full-service, 496-bed hospital
- Services offered: comprehensive cardiovascular care, cancer center, pain management, inpatient & outpatient surgery, digestive health, and level III Neonatology Unit and family maternity center, level II trauma center

Lutheran Hospital

- > 204-bed acute care facility
- Services offered: primary care, orthopedics, behavioral health, emergency medicine, pain management, physical and occupational therapy, rehabilitation, sleep disorder services, sports medicine, urology and wound healing

Main Campus

Union Hospital

- > 100 bed hospital which also has off-campus satellites

Miscellaneous Information

Housing is not provided by Cleveland Clinic, but the Student Housing Program can provide assistance for housing arrangements. Parking is assigned on the first day of rotation at no charge for all Cleveland Clinic locations. Students will have the opportunity to attend multiple education conferences, and access electronic medical records, multiple drug information references, and medical library. Each hospital has a full service cafeteria.

Most of the housing options are fully furnished, and many are within a short car or public transportation ride to the Cleveland Clinic main campus. Some have en suite washers/dryers, fitness centers and free use of computers and printers. The prices vary depending on the unit size and location, availability, and your willingness to share common living spaces and bathrooms. Some establishments may charge an additional fee for utilities and certain amenities, such as Wi-Fi, garage parking and linens.
