### **Requirements**

Advanced Pharmacy Practice Experience (APPE) rotations at the National Institutes of Health (NIH) are determined by the student's interest and preceptor availability. Of note for 2020-2021, APPE rotations will start on September 2020. Please **choose which top three area(s) you are interested in pursuing and the timeframe you would like to complete it.**

**We require that you have completed at least one inpatient acute care APPE rotation prior to your arrival.** In addition, the NIH does not provide housing. Students are responsible for both housing and transportation to and from the NIH campus.

We will **need a copy of your most current curriculum vitae (CV) and a letter of intent (LOI) indicating your professional interests and how those will be accomplished by completing an APPE rotation at our institution.** In the second page of the LOI, please **indicate what months/dates you are available as well as whether you have US citizenship, permanent residency, or are an international student.\*** Please send your CV titled as "Firstname\_lastname\_20 CV" and LOI as "Firstname\_lastname\_20 LOI" by **Friday, November 29<sup>th</sup>, 2019.** Decisions will be made on a rolling basis.
