DESCRIPTION

Chartwell's PGY1 Pharmacy Residency program builds on Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) education to further develop clinical pharmacists prepared to care for patients in an ambulatory setting, i.e. a specialty, home infusion, or clinic-based pharmacy with a focus on population health. Graduates of the program are eligible for board certification and are prepared for postgraduate year two (PGY2) pharmacy residency training.

Integration with the University of Pittsburgh School of Pharmacy and UPMC hospitals will allow for interaction with faculty and students and provides other valuable learning experiences necessary for success in an academic health system.

APPLICATION

To apply, please submit academic transcript, curriculum vitae, letter of intent, and three references (at least one of which must be from a clinical preceptor) by **December 31** via **PhORCAS**. No supplemental application material is required. Selected candidates will be invited for an onsite interview in January or February.

Applicants must be eligible for pharmacy licensure in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.


OUR CAMPUS
