FELLOWSHIP GOALS

- Interact with prescribers, patients and partners to optimize the unique and complex care of rare patients
- Analyze, develop, and implement quality improvement initiatives including pharmacovigilance to further enhance medication safety

- Develop skills required for medication pipeline analysis, management and market forecasting
